

The company is aware of its obligations to manage and control all processes with regard to the protection of the environment. The Case Environmental Policy is a controlled document, endorsed and issued with the authority of the Managing Director. The policy is designed to provide a structured framework for the company's environmental objectives and is established, reviewed and maintained so as to confirm its suitability and relevance to all aspects of the organisation.

The Environmental Policy is communicated to staff at all levels within the organisation.

Environmental objectives are established against relevant processes and are defined within the operating procedures.

The company operates and maintains a documented environmental management system structured against the requirements of the International Standard BS EN ISO 14001:2015.

Senior Management are committed to meeting all compliance obligations, company environmental objectives and to ensuring the implementation of processes to continually improve the environmental management system so as to protect the environment by preventing pollution.

The company operates procedures in the following areas:

- Disposal of general waste
- Disposal of electronic equipment
- Recycling packaging
- Reprocessing selected products
- Minimising the use of fuel by planning engineer deployment and using the vehicle tracking system
- Utilising reduced emissions vehicles within the company fleet

The company aims to be at the forefront of introducing environment initiatives and improvements within the electronic security systems sector by:

- Considering all available options that might deliver an improved environmental solution and drive continual improvement in environmental performance through the setting, implementation and review of policy objectives and targets on an annual basis within the management review
- Ensuring our policies and procedures fully comply with applicable legal and other requirements relating to our environmental impacts
- Taking responsibility for the effective use of resources and the minimisation of wastage
- Preventing pollution and minimising release to land, air and water through effective operational control

Used and obsolete products such as CCTV cameras, monitors and associated control equipment are segregated within the warehouse and proper disposal arranged via an approved waste collection agency in accordance with current directives.



Case is committed to reducing its environmental impact, where practicable. Some of the areas that are included within the business impact analysis are:

- Comply with current energy legislation, seeking to meet or improve upon legislative targets
- Minimise waste; promote recycling and the use of recycled products to help reduce the amount of waste sent to landfill
- Continue to promote environmental awareness and responsibility amongst employees, suppliers, and others and seek to continuously improve company environmental performance
- Evaluate the potential benefits of carbon off-setting
